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## **ABOUT UNIVERSITY**

#### **Samarkand State Medical University**

Samarkand State Medical University, originally established as "State Uzbek Medical Institute" 90 years ago on May 7, 1930, has evolved into one of the most esteemed medical higher educational institutions not only in Uzbekistan but also throughout the entire Central Asian region. By a resolution of the republic government (Resolution of the Council of People's Commisson of Uzbekistan No. 80), the university was founded to address the region's need for an autonomous medical higher education institution.

Following Uzbekistan's independence, Samarkand State Medical Institute (now University) underwent significant developments. In 1997, the government introduced the "National Training Program," followed by the State Health Care Reform Program in 1998. These initiatives led to the establishment of the Faculty of Higher Nursing in 1999, the College of Medical Pedagogy in 2001, and the Faculty of Stomatology, Medical Preventative Medicine, Medical Biology, and Pharmacy in 2005. Students enrolled in a new course called "Traditional Medicine" in the subsequent years.

The university has also established collaborations with prominent foreign universities, including Volga Medical Research University, Chuvash National University named after I.N. Ulyanov (Russia), Ternopol National Medical University named after Y.B. Gorbachevsky (Ukraine), National Louis University Graduate School of Business (Poland), and Belarusian State Medical University (Republic of Belarus). These partnerships enable joint educational programs leading to Bachelor's and Master's degrees.

Moreover, in collaboration with the Korean side, personnel training under the second higher education program is being actively pursued. Beginning with the academic year 2020-2021, students from the Republic of India are being admitted for higher medical study at the institution.

The strategic decision of Uzbekistan's President Shavkat Mirziyoyev, dated April 1, 2022, to establish Samarkand State Medical University based on the Samarkand State Medical Institute signifies the institution's commitment to embody the most advanced achievements of local and international experience. The university has a strong scientific and pedagogical capacity, diverse material and technological resources, and a long history of training skilled medical professionals.

According to the presidential decree, the educational process should focus on developing practical skills through the widespread implementation of advanced pedagogical technologies, curricula, and innovative materials based on international educational standards. The university aims to create an environment that combines theoretical knowledge and practice in the clinic and the educational base, and it seeks to develop academic mobility programs for students, teachers, and researchers working with foreign medical universities. The university is also committed to conducting fundamental, applied, and innovative research to address existing problems in medical practice and gradually introduce the concept of "University 3.0," which integrates medical education, science, and practical healthcare with real sectors of the economy.

Today, Samarkand State Medical University offers instruction across nine faculties and nine Bachelor's degrees, providing a comprehensive medical education to students from diverse backgrounds.

## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**


- → Submit scanned copies of your 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade results, NEET scores, passport, or Aadhaar card (if your passport is pending) to your assigned counselor via their official email for verification purposes.
- → Remit the registration fee to the company's account, or make an online payment through the company's website.
- → Validate your payment and receive a payment receipt from your counselor.
- → Once the university issues the admission letter, your counselor will email it to you.
- → Dispatch the original copies of your 10th and 12th grade results and passport via courier to our office address: DREAM MBBS STUDY ABROAD LLP, 1218, 12th Floor, Ithum Tower-B, Sector 62, Noida, Uttar Pradesh, 201301, or submit them in person at the aforementioned address.
- → Remit the documentation fees to the company's account, or make an online payment via the company's website.

- → We will initiate the documentation process and submit the necessary documents to facilitate the issuance of the invitation letter. Your counselor will share the invitation letter after the relevant authority issues it.


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## **CAMPUS BUILDINGS**

The Medical Library of Samarkand State Medical University was established in 1934 and initially situated within the premises of the university's multi-profile clinic (Clinic No.1). From the beginning, the library faced various challenges, such as organizing and standardizing its book collection and painstakingly creating catalogues. In its early years, the library's collection comprised around 30,000 printed materials.

Several notable individuals, including Prof. G.G. Abdullaev, P.N. Karlenko, F.M. Golub, I.P. Mishchenko, P.M. Isayev, F.I. Shevchenko, Associate Professors H.R. Farkhadi, M. Asadulin, M.G. Iren, and D.H. Rakhmanov, contributed literature to the library's collection. During World War II, the S.M. Kirov Military Medical College was evacuated to Samarkand, leaving behind unique and uncommon editions as a form of legacy. Many of these editions are considered rare, as most of the books date back to the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries.

The library's collection includes the renowned "Encyclopaedia of Medical Sciences" by F.A. Brockhaus and I.A. Efron (1890-1907), the "Real Encyclopaedia of Medical Sciences" (1891), and works on anatomy, physiology, surgery, obstetrics, gynecology, as well as doctoral and candidate theses. The writings of notable medical science founders, such as Sechenov, Pavlov, and Pirogov, are well represented in the collection and hold significant cultural and scientific value.

In 1939, the library's collection comprised 37,000 books, growing to 78,000 by 1949. At present, the library houses over 350,000 books. Starting with merely 200 readers, including 105 students and 56 instructors, the library now serves more than 8,000 users. The Medical Library of Samarkand State Medical University plays a vital role in fostering knowledge advancement.

Currently, the library, as part of the Information and Resource Centre (IRC), is regularly updated with the latest medical, related, and other materials published by renowned national and international publishing companies. The IRC fund at Samarkand State Medical University features nearly 350,000 printed units of academic, scientific, pedagogical, methodological, fiction, and international literature. The collection includes 110,950 copies of educational literature and 182,861 copies of scientific literature. Departments have access to essential textbooks and study aids in English and German, alongside materials in Uzbek (Latin and Cyrillic) and Russian. The international literature collection boasts over 10,000 printed works.










### **FOREIGN STUDENTS**

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#### FOREIGN STUDENTS STUDYING AT THE UNIVERSITY

Currently, over 3,000 international students are enrolled at Samarkand State Medical University, with around 2,200 of them coming from India. The university started admitting international students to its medical programs in 2019. In the first year, less than 100 international students were recruited, but this number saw a significant increase in just over three years. In 2022 alone, Samarkand State Medical University welcomed over 900 Indian students. The rapid influx of Indian students from Ukraine, due to the Russia-Ukraine conflict, contributed to the university's growing popularity and demand among foreign students, particularly Indians, who were drawn to its education system and licensing process. Samarkand State Medical University has earned a strong reputation among international students for its high-quality education and clinical experience. International students are recruited through the university's official partners, one of which is DREAM MBBS STUDY ABROAD LLP. There are ample dormitory accommodations available for international students. However, many opt for apartments to ensure privacy, and these are readily available to foreign nationals without discrimination. Uzbek people are known for their hospitality, which adds to the welcoming environment for international students. The university's accreditations from prestigious organizations also attract international students to the institution.



The safety of international students studying at higher education institutions in Uzbekistan is fully protected by the Republic of Uzbekistan's Constitution and other legislation. As such, foreign students are required to comply with the country's Constitution and legal framework. Samarkand State Medical University maintains a dedicated police unit to assist and advise students in the event of an emergency. The university has appointed a sergeant who is in constant communication with the dean of the foreign faculty to keep the university informed about students' whereabouts and prevent potential risks. International students are not allowed to leave the dormitory after 10 p.m. during the summer and 9:30 p.m. during the winter. If students living in apartments are found wandering the city late at night, the sergeant informs the respective dean, and strict measures are taken the next day to prevent future incidents. ## LYCEUMS AND CLINICS









#### **CLINIC OF SAMARKAND STATE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY**

### 1. Clinic 1 (Clinic SamMI)

SamSMU's Multidisciplinary Clinic (1st clinic) is a pioneer in Central Asia as one of the region's first significant interdisciplinary hospitals. Construction began in 1926 following cutting-edge designs of the time and commenced operations in 1929 as the "Republican Hospital," when Samarkand was Uzbekistan's capital. In 1930, with the founding of the Uzbek State Medical Institute in Samarkand, the Republican Hospital was transferred to the Institute and granted clinic status. As a vital component of the University, SamSMU's multifunctional clinic (1st clinic) serves as the primary educational and scientific-treatment foundation for training medical staff. Over the years, the clinic has undergone significant changes during its independence, including departmental reforms and updates, extensive building repairs and restoration, and the strengthening of its material and technological infrastructure. Over 300 state-of-the-art medical devices from countries like Japan, Germany, Russia, the United States, South Korea, China, and the United Kingdom have been installed. The Multidisciplinary Clinic (1st clinic) at Samarkand State Medical University houses 17 clinical departments that offer comprehensive conditions for mastering clinical knowledge, acquiring practical skills, and conducting research activities. Today, the multifunctional clinic (1st clinic) serves as a modern medical and diagnostic center for the southeastern and northwestern regions of the country. The clinic caters to 19,000 in-patients and over 100,000 out-patients annually, performs 3,000-3,500 births, and conducts more than 6,000 surgical interventions for patients from various regions of Uzbekistan, as well as citizens from neighboring republics. Additionally, over 500,000 laboratory tests and 100,000 Xray, ultrasound, endoscopic, and other functional tests are performed each year. The hospital's name has changed several times throughout its history, adapting to the needs and circumstances of the time. However, its role as the university's primary teaching and research-treatment base, and its prominence and importance in the public's consciousness as a national hospital, have remained constant. The primary objective of SamSMU's Multidisciplinary Clinic (1st clinic) is to provide university students with the necessary conditions to gain theoretical knowledge and practical skills in clinical disciplines and to offer quality inpatient and outpatient care to Uzbekistan's citizens and non-residents, in accordance with the Ministry's established procedures.

## 2. Clinic 2 (Center For Pediatric Surgery)

In 1990, Prof. A. Shamsiev led the establishment of the Multidisciplinary Specialized Centre for Children's Surgery, commonly known as "Clinic 2," at SamSMU. Since 2013, Professor Zhamshid Azamatovich Shamsiev has served as the clinic's chief physician. Today, the Multidisciplinary Specialized Centre for Pediatric Surgery (2nd Clinic) at Samarkand State Medical University is a specialized multidisciplinary research clinical institution, providing high-quality round-the-clock medical care for children in the Samarkand, Jizzakh, Navoi, Bukhara, Kashkadarya, Surkhandarya, and Khorezm regions. The hospital also serves as a world-class methodological center for various critical areas in pediatric surgery. Each year, approximately 21,000 patients visit the clinic, with over 10,000 of them requiring hospitalization. The clinic performs more than 8,000 complex plastic and reconstructive procedures on the heart, lungs, liver, intestines, organs of the urogenital system, and the musculoskeletal apparatus. For the first time in the Samarkand region's pediatric surgical practice, the center has introduced operations for congenital heart diseases, bronchiectatic disease, funnel chest deformity, liver cirrhosis, congenital diseases of the urogenital system, malformations of the large intestine, peptic ulcer and duodenal ulcer, laparoscopic and thoracoscopic operations, endoscopic transurethral cystoscopic stenting of the ureter and renal pelvis, endocollagenoplasty for vesicoureteral reflux, sclerotherapy for varicocele in children, as well as bronchoscopy, bronchography, plasmapheresis, splenosorption, ozone therapy, and more. The clinic maintains strong scientific relationships with respected international medical centers, enabling its professionals to participate in international scientific symposia for continued education. In 2016, the clinic's team became the first Central Asian members of the Endoscopic and Laparoscopic Surgical Association of Asia (ELSA). Specialists from the clinic have received training in neonatal surgery centers in Astana (Kazakhstan), the pediatric surgery center of Stavropol Medical University (Russia), Severans clinics of Yonsei University and Samsung Hospital (South Korea), and the National University Hospital (Singapore) between 2016 and 2019. In return, specialists from Russia, Kazakhstan, and South Korea have visited the clinic and conducted "Master classes" on performing endosurgery. Memoranda of Mutual Collaboration have been signed between Samsung Hospital, National University Hospital (Singapore), and the Multidisciplinary Pediatric Surgery Centre at Samarkand State Medical University (2nd Clinic).











#### Food & Accommodation

Samarkand State Medical University offers four dormitories with the capacity to accommodate 1,300 students. These dormitories, located at 37 Dagbitskaya Street (Dormitory No. 1), 41 Dagbitskaya Street (Dormitory No. 2), and 31 & 31/A G. Jamshid Street (Dormitories No. 3 and No. 4), cater to the needs of both local and international students from countries such as Korea, India, and Pakistan. Each dormitory is equipped with university library branches containing over 3,000 essential literary works, providing all students with easy access to these resources. To enhance students' living conditions and cultural leisure, every floor features refrigerators, TV sets, and modern furnishings in all rooms. A state-of-the-art heating system ensures the dormitories remain comfortable during winter months. Students also have access to showers and laundry facilities on each floor, with modern washing machines and gas ovens available for use. Furthermore, all dormitories feature contemporary computer rooms with Wi-Fi and internet connections. Each dormitory houses "Rooms of Spirituality," which are equipped with necessary tools and visual aids, allowing students to engage in spiritual and educational activities during their free time. The University's Spirituality and Education Department, the Youth Union of Uzbekistan's primary organization, the Women's Advisory Council, faculties, and departments frequently organize programs and round tables on various topics in the dorms' Spirituality Rooms. Additionally, Indian mess halls are available in the dorms, where students can enjoy authentic Indian cuisine prepared by Indian chefs at affordable prices. Students utilizing the mess facilities receive nutritious, protein-rich Indian meals three times a day, contributing to their optimal physical and mental health.

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
